Philanthropy Chair-Mary Johnson

Lake Hills School

Provides learning opportunities to meet the developmental and intellectual needs of students with various disabilities. Our donations help purchase devices, bikes, iPads and software. Received \$8,800 from HHLC.

Forward Paths Foundation

Our donation was used to assist young adults aging out of foster care with housing, transportation and mentoring costs. Received \$9,800 from HHLC.

Fruitland Park and The Villages Elementary Schools

Our donations helped purchase clothing for students in need, where the majority are at or below the poverty level. This allowed these children to attend school with dignity. Each school received \$1,500 from HHLC.

Community Medical Care Center

Provides free medical, dental, eye clinic for adults who don't qualify for state or federal insurance programs. Our donation is used for lab work, pap smears, mammograms, and psa tests. Received \$8,800 from HHLC.

The Haven

A home for women and children of domestic abuse. Last year our donation upgraded the security cameras and put in a new gate at the residence. Received \$6,910.26 from HHLC.

Christian Food Pantry Our donation is used to help provide food and basic need items to 400 to 500 clients each month. At Thanksgiving and Christmas every client is given a turkey or ham dinner. Our donations are used to supplement these holiday dinners if needed. Received \$7,025 from HHLC.

Beacon College

Beacon College is committed to students who have learning disabilities, ADHD, dyslexia or other differences. Learning specialists help students toward a four-year degree. HHLC will support the scholarship program.
