Lake Hills School

Provides learning opportunities to meet the developmental and intellectual needs of students with various disabilities. Our donations help purchase devices, bikes, iPads and software.
Received \$10,000 from HHLC.

Forward Paths Foundation

Our donation was used to assist young adults aging out of foster care with housing, transportation and mentoring costs to build a path to independence.
Received \$9,000 from HHLC.

Fruitland Park and The Villages Elementary Schools

Our donations helped purchase clothing for students in need, where the majority are at or below the poverty level. This allowed these children to attend school with dignity.
Each school received \$1,500 from HHLC.

Community Medical Care Center

Provides free medical, dental, eye clinic for adults who don't qualify for state or federal insurance programs.

A home for women and children of domestic abuse. Victims and their dependent children receive temporary emergency shelter, food, clothing, and counseling.
